





What have we learnt this week?

Reception classes... This week, we doubled and halved everything in our classrooms! We wrote 'super sentences' about Jack and the Beanstalk and observed how our beanstalks had grown. We also wrote some fantastic letters to the giant! At home, please help your child to practise their learning of 'halving and doubling' using items in and around the house.

Year 1... This week we wrote the story 'The Snail and the Whale'. In Maths, we worked out the missing number in number sentences. In topic, we planted seeds and beans and talked about what they need to grow. At home, please talk to your child about plants and how they grow. Also, see what shapes you can find in your house. Can you find cubes, cuboids, spheres, cylinders and pyramids? AND please read with your child every day!

Year 2... This week the children have been working on the story of Red Riding Hood. We also worked hard to solve problems using our multiplication and division skills. At home, please help your child at home by playing number bond and multiplication games on the 'topmarks' website.

Year 3... This week we practised adding and subtracting fractions. We also wrote our own versions of our Wallace and Gromit story. In Topic, we finished our volcano sculptures and learned about how volcanos are formed. At home, please ask your child what they have learned about volcanos this week!

Year 4... This week we learnt about angles in Maths. In Literacy, we wrote our own non-chronological reports on a fantasy land, and in Topic, we made some special telephones to help us learn how sound travels. At home, please help your child to learn their times tables.

Year 5... This week we learnt about the properties of 2D shapes: parallel lines, perpendicular lines, angles, sides and perimeter. In literacy we wrote our report on planets. We used a range of punctuation: commas, dashes, semicolons, colons and question marks. Working on our Topic, we used chalk to create artwork to represent Space! Help your child at home by practising joined, neat handwriting when completing your homework!

Year 6... All of the children have been working hard in their SATs tests this week The teachers are so proud of them for their efforts! In the afternoons, we relaxed by taking part in art activities, including clay work and sketching, music lessons and athletics. At home, please praise your child for their incredible efforts and give them a weekend to RELAX!
