I have 4 packs of oreos with 5 oreos in each pack.

I then eat 2.









$$20 - 2 = 18$$

How many oreos do I have left? 18 oreos left

1. Miss Ellison-Smith has 6 piles of books. Each pile has 10 books in. She then loses 3 books.















$$6 \times 10 = 60$$

$$60 - 3 = 57$$

How many books does she have left? 57 books

2. A farmer shares 30 of his cows into 5 fields











$$30 \div 5 = 6$$

He then add I more cow to each field. How many cows are in each field? 7 cows

3. I go to the shop and buys 2 bunches of grapes and 3 pies. How much money do I spend altogether? £23

$$2 \times 4 = 8$$
 $3 \times 5 = 15$

$$15 + 8 = 23$$



4. A squirrel has 48 nuts but eats 8 of them. He then puts 10 nuts in each hole.

$$48 - 8 = 40$$

How many holes does he need? 4 holes

5. Mr Rosetti has 9 footballs. He then finds 5 more.

$$9 + 5 = 14$$



He shares all the footballs between 2 children.

$$14 \div 2 = 7$$

How many footballs do they get each? 7 footballs
