Can you remember what a suffix is?

A suffix is letters that are added onto the end of root words to create new words.

Today we are going to look at the suffix...

The suffix -ly is added onto adjectives to form adverbs.

Most of the time —ly is just added onto the end of the root word. HOWEVER if the root word ends in y. The y is taken off and turned into an 'i' before ly is added.
