
## Wednesday — division word problems

$$14 \div 2 = 7 \text{ pots}$$

2. Miss Ellison-Smith has 10 rubbers. She shares them between 10 children. How many rubbers does each child get?









3. A squirrel has 15 nuts. He puts 5 nuts in each hole. How many holes does he









$$15 \div 5 = 3$$
 holes

4. A pet shop owner has 18 fish. He shares them between 2 tanks. How many fish are in each tank?





$$18 \div 2 = 9$$

6. Kimi has 12 sweets. She shares them between herself and her two friends. How many sweets do they get each?  $12 \div 3 = 4$
