We were pleased to welcome back Year 4 this week and look forward to having Lavender back on Monday and reopening More 4 Kids.

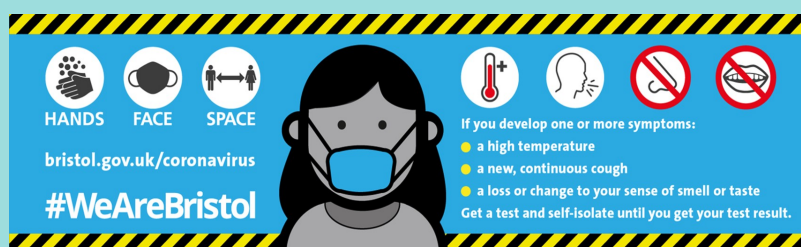

This week's learning ...

Reception

This week we ordered pictures from 'The Gingerbread Man' and followed clues to find out where he was hiding. In phonics we learnt some new sounds. As mathematicians we learnt about numbers 4 and 5 and enjoyed being '4 detectives' in our 'Forest explore' session on the field! **Please help at home by being number detectives. Find groups of 4 and 5 objects and send us a photo on Tapestry!**

Year 1

We worked so hard this week! We wrote a diary as a character from our class book - it was challenging but we all did our best. Our Year 1 adults are very proud. In maths we learnt to 'find the difference'. You can help at home by reading daily with your child and helping them to learn their tricky words. Compare the numbers and use the words 'more than' and 'less than'.

Year 2

Year 2 worked really hard this week on their maths and reading assessments! Teachers are very impressed with their concentration skills and perseverance. They learnt about the GWR and how people felt about it being built. **Help at home by practising your sounds and reading every night. Practise counting forwards and backwards to 100. Practise simple number bonds to 10.**



Kestrel and Eagle have learnt totally different things this week! Kestrel learnt to use factors and multiples in maths and explored semi-colons and explanation texts in English. Eagle learnt to use and compare fractions in maths and began preparing to write a non-chronological report in English. **Help at home by asking your child to show you how to find all the factor pairs of any number.**

Year 3

Year 3 have done a brilliant job at settling into home learning this week. In English and enquiry they looked at tectonic plates and earthquakes and built their own house to withstand an earthquake. As mathematicians they practised their 3 times table. **Please help at home by learning the 3 and 4 times tables. Encourage your child to read every day in a fluent voice.**

Year 4

The children are back in school now and we have loved seeing their happy faces! As mathematicians, we multiplied by 10 and 100. As authors we finished 'Fantastic Mr Fox' which we really enjoyed! We invented our own stories with all our own ideas. As part of 'Acts of Kindness Week' we made flowers for our partner class in Year 2! **You can help at home by practising times tables with you child.**

Year 5

This week we've done lots of performance practice and it's already looking fantastic. As artists we thought about textures to add to our building and as writers we became journalists writing about a runaway orphan. The children also tried really hard during their tests. **Please help your child practise their lines for the performance. We don't want to be using scripts next week!**
