Applying for a secondary school place.

If your child is now in Year 6, you must apply online for a secondary school place before the deadline of 31st October. Open days at secondary schools are happening throughout September and October. Lists of these open sessions have been sent home today and are also available from the school office. Please make time to visit our nearest school, City Academy, whose results have improved massively over the last two years. Their open days are every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 12 September-18 October.

What have been learning?

Year 1 ... This week Year I read and explored a book called 'Dogs don't do ballet'. We thought about the character's likes and dislikes and then about our own interests. As Artists, we have been drawing our families and creating collages of our faces. Please read with your children at home and practising counting numbers 1-20, starting at any number.

Year 2 ... This week Year 2 settled into their new classes. They have done a fantastic job of remembering our school rules and showing off gold standard behaviour. Please make sure your child remembers to bring their book bag everyday. At home, practise counting in ones and tens.

This week Year 4 read and explored a book called 'The Name Jar'. We have thought about how the character feels about joining a new school in a new country and we wrote diary entries. As Artists, we have been drawing self-portraits using photos of ourselves. At home, please read with your children and practise your times tables.

Year 3

This week Year 3 began to explore the story of 'Grace and family'. We used clues from the text to understand the main character. In our Enquiry we have been exploring how families are different and where our families come from! Please read with your child at home. Also, help them to find a family picture to bring in to school next week.

Year 5

We started to look at a book called 'The Promise'. From this we came up with adventurous word choices which we used when writing a free verse poem. We also began a new enquiry about the local area which we will be excited to share with parents next week. Please make sure your child has the correct PE kit for Tuesday and swimming kit ready for Thursday!

Year 6 ... It has been lovely settling in to Year 6 these first 3 days! We did some art (we even made origami swans using our resilience), read and discussed our humorous class books and even fitted in some maths. The children have showed that we're going to have a fab year in Year 6 this year! At home, talk to your child about how they're feeling about being in Year 6 so far and what they're excited about.
