What is More 4 Kids?

... we're a friendly after school club for Hannah More children, with 20 places available each day. The club has been running since 2002! The club is all about PLAY and we make full use of the school playground and our own clubhouse. Children love coming to More 4 Kids and everyone gets along well together. We follow the school values of ENJOYMENT, NURTURE, RESPECT, OPENNESS and DETERMINATION.

What happens at More 4 Kids?

... we collect younger children from their classrooms at the end of the school day. Older children come on their own. We start with something to eat (pasta, jacket potatoes, fish fingers, beans on toast etc.) and we chat about our day. Children then choose to play outside or ride bikes or stay inside for a quieter activity like craft or cooking. Then there's a drink and biscuit before more play or another activity.

Who runs the club?

... the club is managed by the school and run by a play leader and deputy play leader. We also have some University volunteers who help us. All staff, including volunteers, have a DBS check and relevant training.
