Ecception Lots of rehearsing for our nativity this week. We are very excited to perform for you next week. In phonics we have been learning to 'chop up' longer words to read them. As mathematicians we learnt all about the number four. At home: If you have lines, please practise saying them in a loud, clear voice.

This week Year 1 wrote as Historians about toys from the past in preparation for our toy museum next week. In maths we explored fact families and compared number sentences. At home please read with your child 5 times a week. Practise reading tricky words by sight. Practise number bonds to 10 and subtracting numbers within 10 e.g. 9-5=4

Year 2

This week Year 2 made delicious pizza and wrote instructions. As mathematicians they looked at money and as scientists they carried out an experiment on the affect of exercise on heart rate! Please read with your child 5 times a week. Show your child the different coins and note when buying things in shops. Ask them to

This week we continued to learn our times tables. We learnt to divide and multiply. In English we wrote a non-chronological report all about Volcanoes.

We will make these reports into a book which we will share in our class library. Please read with your child as often as possible and encourage them to practise their 2, 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

The Year 4 children have been mathematicians, writers and scientists. They spotted patterns in multiplying and dividing by 0 and 1. They begun writing very detailed fact files on British animals, which they researched themselves. They enjoyed their very last swimming lesson of the year on Thursday, where they learned some important tips about water safety. Please help your child with their times tables and spelling lists.

We took a trip to Bristol Old Vic on Tuesday to pick up some tips from the amazing actors and actresses in Robin Hood. We practised our performance The Snow Queen lots this week! Parents & carers - we will be performing on Tuesday afternoon, we will send a text with timings. **Please help your child with multiplication tables and weekly spellings**.



This week Year 6 have been authors and scientists. They wrote very detailed descriptive explanations about the process of

mummification. As scientists they discussed carrying out a fair test and some of the features such as hypothesis, variables (dependent, controlled and independent). **Please help your child with their times tables and spelling list.**
