1. Where do Kashmiri goats normally roam?  
The nearby hills in Llandudno, Wales.
2. Where are they roaming now that humans are in lockdown?  
In the town of Llandudno.
3. Name 4 other locations around the world and the behaviour of the animals there.
  1. Japan – Sika deer have been in the streets and subway stations.
  2. Israel – Wild boars and jackals have been seen in the streets
  3. Florida – there have been more turtle nests seen
  4. The Bosphorus – dolphins have been seen swimming and jumping
4. What is the difference that scientists have seen in the leatherback turtles?  
There have been more turtle nests seen by scientists than last year.
5. Name 2 ways that having less humans around has meant that animals have benefited.
  1. Birds can be heard by other birds better.
  2. More chicks are likely to survive and grow up healthy.
6. What does the author of this article mean by noise pollution? Can you give any examples of things that might cause noise pollution?  
Noise pollution is when there is noise made by sources that aren't natural.  
For example, machinery being operated such as cars and trucks.
7. What do you think could happen to the animals if lockdown stops in those countries?  
The animals may get affected by pollution (both noise pollution and air pollution) again once humans start going back to work and school and travelling more again.
8. Do you think there is anything humans can do to help the animals once lockdown stops? Name 3 ways.
  1. Use cars less
  2. Stop dropping litter
  3. Big companies could think more carefully about how their activity impacts the environment and the surrounding wildlife.
