

Here is a blue strip of paper.



Bevel 3

An orange strip is four times as long.



The strips are joined end to end.



This one was especially tricky!

How long is the blue strip? $\frac{1}{4}$ cm. The orange strip is $\frac{1}{4}$ times as long $\frac{1}{4}$ x $\frac{1}{4}$ = $\frac{1}{6}$

How long is the orange strip? 16 cm

Can you create your own question similar to this?

A bottle contains 4 litres of juice.

Stella needs 30 litres of juice for a party.

She has 12 bottles.

Does she have enough juice? How do you know?

I think she does have enough juice because $4 \times 12 = 48$ which is more than 30.
